

GOD CAN'T GIVE YOU WHAT HE HAS ALREADY GIVEN TO YOU!

2 Peter 1:2-4

2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you **through** the **knowledge** of God, and **of Jesus** our Lord,

3 According as His divine power **hath given** unto us **all things** that pertain **unto life and godliness**, through the **knowledge of him** that hath called us to glory and virtue:

4 whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be **partakers of the divine nature**, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

If you have to ask God **for** something, then you don't understand what He has done for you – you don't know what you have! All you have to do is ask God to open your eyes of understanding to what belongs to you – to what is yours! *That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you **the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him: the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of His mighty power, which He wrought in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and set Him at His own right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: and hath put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him that filleth all in all.** (Ephesians 1:17-23)*

If you are praying FOR something that you already have, that wouldn't make any sense, would it? God can't give you what He has already given to you, right? You can just picture God in Heaven asking Jesus, "Didn't you tell them, Jesus? Didn't you tell them what I did for them – that you accomplished everything that I sent you do? – That they are more than conquerors because you conquered Satan for them....that he is defeated? Didn't you tell them that you gave all of your power, and the authority to use it, to them? Didn't you tell them, Jesus? Why do they keep asking me for the things you bought for them with your own precious blood? Don't they realize that the scourging you took was for them – for their healing, so they would never have to be sick a day in their lives? Don't they know that they don't have to live by this world's economy system – that I AM their provider? I AM El-Shaddai, and I AM more than enough for them! I AM all they need!

Why, oh why, do they keep seeking after the things they want and the things of this world instead of seeking after me? In Me all of their needs ARE met! In Me, all of their prayers, according to My Word, is already yes and Amen! In Me, they have ALL they need, and I give them the desires that I place in their hearts! (Psalm 37:4) Don't they know it is only through the faith that I put within them that they can walk in my promises (their inheritance) – that by praising me and thanking me for what they have in Me, they will see it come to pass with their natural eyes? They have to know that they are my most prized creation! I want them to know that I love them with an unconditional and everlasting love! My desire for them is that they surrender their lives over to me – that they receive my Son, Jesus, as Lord of their lives, so they can be my Son also, and receive their inheritance in Me and learn to live in it! I want to be **one** with them in Spirit as You and I are, Jesus!"

You can't ask God for more faith, power, or authority. You can't ask for more of Jesus' peace, love or joy. You can't even ask for more of God, as some people sing about! Think about it: when you received Jesus, you received **ALL** of Him, not just a part or portion of Him! As you read God's Word, you will gain more **knowledge** of Him, which is what you need. *Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on Him, **If ye continue in My Word, then are ye my disciples indeed; and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.** (John 8:31, 32)* When you truly belong to God, you can command what you desire to come forth from within you! (once you realize it's inside of you!) *That the **communication of thy faith** may become **effectual** by the **acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.** (Philemon 1:6)*

*And Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have faith in God.** For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall **say** unto this mountain, **Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.** Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye **pray**, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses. (Mark 11:22-26)*

Do you realize that the first part of these verses are telling you that all you have to do is **speak** God's Word for something to come to pass, and the second part tells you how to **pray**. Notice that it only mentions praying one time, and it talks about saying three times! Whether you say it or pray it, through faith you have to **believe** what you are saying will come to pass! The greatest faith that there is, is to be expecting what you are believing for to come to pass! If you are praying, confessing, and stressing about something, that is not the faith of God. If after you spoke the Word over a situation, and yet your thoughts are questioning whether or not it will actually happen, you are not in faith and it won't work – that's not the God kind of faith. If all you ever use is natural faith, which says that when I flip this light switch my lights will come on and not truly believe God and His never failing Word which says you were healed by Jesus' stripes, (1 Peter 2:24) then you will probably never attain your healing in the natural without the help of another believer who knows the Word and his rights!

If you are a born again believer, you are supposed to not only be walking in divine health, and never needing healing yourself, but you are supposed to be laying hands on others and healing them also! *And these signs shall follow them that **believe**; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. (Mark 16:17, 18)* You have your healing – you have the healer inside of you! You have Jesus' authority and His power to perform it! This is not an option if you are a believer, it's a command from God – you shall!

In order to believe God's Word over what the mountain appears to be in front of you, you have to read God's Word (plant it) and let it take root inside of you. You have to get exposed to the promises of God, meditate on them, speak them out, and thank and praise God for what He's done in your situation before you see it with your natural eyes! You have to see it as a done deal through your eyes of faith (your spiritual eyes) just as God sees it! Don't forget - every promise of God is yes and Amen! It is finished! All you have to do is spend time with the Lord and let Him renew your mind to the way He thinks and believes, which is revealed in His Word! God wants to restore your mind and make it brand new. *That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt*

according to the deceitful lusts; and **be renewed in the spirit of your mind**; and that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. (Ephesians 4:22-24)

When you were born again, you became a brand new being – one that never existed before! *Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a **new creature**: old things are passed away; behold, **all things are become new.*** (2 Corinthians 5:17) You do have the mind of Christ (1 Corinthians 1:16) but until you let the Holy Spirit renew your mind from the old ways of thinking you have always had, which are negative, carnal, and worldly, (unbelieving and sinful) to the new and fresh way of thinking which believes God's Word over every situation that ever arises in your life! You are a new creature if you are born of God and **all things are new** in you. You have a brand new spirit, which is of God – His Holy Spirit! You have a brand new inheritance, which is all good, and your old one that you were born with was done away with! You don't have any past in Christ. You don't have any generational problems, whether mental, physical, or financial! Your past generation goes straight to Jesus, and there is absolutely no sickness or disease in Him! There are no financial problems in Him! There is no mental disease in Him! You have a brand new life in Christ, but until you learn what all is in your new inheritance, you will never be able to walk in it or in victory over your problems - the things the devil tries to throw your way.

All you have to do is get what you already have in the heart of you, (if you have been born again) into your head through gaining knowledge of God and His Word- it is crucial! *My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.* (Hosea 4:6a) Jesus is not dead – **He's alive, and He is alive in you!** It's time to let Him have the freedom that He deserves – it's time to loose Him and let Him out of you! Choose to let Him work through you and spread His love to a dying world! Decide to be all Jesus needs you to be and to obey him by setting the captives free and healing the sick and even raising the dead! The people around you can't be set free by you until you are free from being held back from the devil and then by you letting Jesus have free reign in your life – by making Him **Lord of your life** and by **obeying** His Word!
