WALK IN THE SPIRIT

Mark 11:23

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall **say** unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and **shall not doubt in his heart**, but shall **believe** that those things which he **saith shall come to pass**; he **shall have whatsoever he saith**.

You have what you say when you BELIEVE it in your HEART. (in your SPIRIT) If you are purposely confessing things that you want but you're still in the flesh when you say it, you won't have what you say - but if you are in the Spirit when you say it, you will have what you say because you will truly believe it in your heart - Spirit! Flesh produces flesh but Spirit produces Spirit! That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. (John 3:6) This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. (Galatians 5:16)

In order to walk in the Spirit, you have to GET into the Spirit. You have to cross over from the flesh, (the natural world) and into the spiritual world where God operates! You have to be spending time with the Lord on a daily, minute by minute relationship with Him! You can't be thinking that you have to GO and meet with Him, because He is always with you! Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. Hebrews 13:5 You have to make a conscious decision that you BELIEVE the Word of God where it says that He will NEVER leave you or forsake you! You have to be in constant fellowship with Him, which is what the Bible.calls walking in the Spirit. You are a spirit, made in the image and likeness of God, (Genesis 1:26) Himself - your creator, and in order to actually KNOW Him and walk with Him you have to walk where He walks - in the Spirit! He wants you to worship Him in Spirit and in Truth. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth. (John 4:24) He wants you to also pray in the Spirit. Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints. (Ephesians 6:18)

God wants you to constantly and consistently BE in the Spirit so you can be a true son of God, just as Jesus is, and operating on this earth just as He did when He was here, physically. You are supposed to be Jesus to the people in your life, witnessing to them and being an example to them of what it truly means to be a son of the most High God! You are supposed to be showing forth God's awesome power in your life, not only over sin, but also DOING what the Bible says to Do! You are supposed to be a doer of the Word, not just only a hearer! But be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. (James 1:22) You are supposed to be healing the sick and casting out demons! And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. (Mark 16:17, 18) You are supposed to be setting the captives/oppressed free and raising the dead! And as ye go, preach, saying, the kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils; freely ye have received, freely give. (Matthew 10:7, 8) God says you can do all these things and more! Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. (John 14:12)

God has equipped you to do the things that He has commanded you to do, and if you give Him the opportunity, He will always come through! He desires to show His power to the dying world around you. he wants to show them that there is hope in Him. He wants to give them freedom - the same freedom that you have! God doesn't play favoritism. He wants all people to come to Him and to be free! The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that **all should come to repentance**. (2 Peter 3:9)

And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:

that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. (John 3:14-18) God loves you so much that He gave you His very own Son to set you free from the bondages of Satan. He came in the flesh to rescue you!

Jesus came to give you life to the max! The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. (John 10:10) Jesus doesn't just want to give you a more abundant life on this earth that you already have - the life that you have on this earth in the natural may not be that great to you! The LIFE that Jesus has though - spiritual LIFE, is amazing! It is abundant and it is excellent! If your life is dull and uneventful, and you don't feel very excited about living it, then get to know the One Who created you! Get in the Spirit with Him and you will see the most amazing things that you have ever seen, and you will do the most amazing things through Him that you never even thought was possible! Get in the Spirit and begin to speak God's Word over all of the situations in your life and believe what you are saying to be true, because God's Word is true! See the things come to pass that you desire to see (according to God's Word) in the Spirit as a done deal, and praise and thank God for them! That's when you will see it come to pass in the natural realm. The spiritual realm has certain laws just like the natural realm does, such as gravity, and you just have to learn how to operate in the Spirit like Jesus did - in faith! Remember: With God ALL things are possible!!!!! (Matthew 19:26) Jesus loves you!
