

## See God's Vision For You!

*Where there is no vision, the people **perish**: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he. (Proverbs 29:18)*

In this new year, 2019, what are the goals for your life? What is the vision which God has put within you? God said in His Word that if you don't have a vision for your life, you will perish! You will give your enemy, which is the devil, an inroad into your life! You are not here by mistake - you are here for a purpose. *For I know the **plans** I have for you, declares the Lord, **plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future** (Jeremiah 29:11).* God has **big plans** for your life! He not only says He has a plan, He has a **good** plan intended for you! He actually has plans for a bright future for you, and to prosper you in ways that you cannot even imagine! He has plans to bless you beyond your wildest dreams! God actually knew you and chose you before the foundation of the Earth. Before He ever even created anything, you were on His mind - He knew you. *According as He hath **chosen us in Him** before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love (Ephesians 1:4).*

You are the apple of God's eye. Andrew Wommack says that God has a picture of him in his wallet and an 8 by 10 picture of him hanging on his wall. And he thinks the same of you and me, He loves us! So what about your goals and visions? Do they coincide with God the creator of Heaven and Earth's vision for you or not? Think of how a pair of binoculars work - you adjust them to focus in on what you were trying to see and the more you focus in, the better you can see (the better your **vision** is). **God** is the one with **the perfect vision** for your life. The more you **focus** in on Him and what he has for you, the more clearly His plans and purposes for your life will become to you. *But **seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you** (Matthew 6:33).* God said to seek him first above everything in this world. He wants to be the one to add to your life because He not only knows what **is** best for you, but He is the one that **has** the best for you - better than you could **ever** add to your life on your own! Yes God's vision for your life a **perfect vision**, better than 20/20, which is what next year's date will be - 2020! Don't wait till next year, don't put it off. If you start now, focusing in on God's vision for you, by the year 2020 you will **see** God bring many things to pass already in your life and your vision will match His! You will have better than 2020 spiritual vision!

Always remember that you are blessed to be a blessing to those around you. *And I will make of thee a great nation, and **I will bless thee**, and make thy name great; and **thou shalt be a blessing** (Genesis 12:2).* As God increases you in your

finances, you are responsible to reach out and help those around you financially. **If God can get it through you He will get it to you!** If you decide not to let what God has given to you flow out from you, then you will stop the flow and eventually it will quit flowing even to you! Be a giver!

Its the same with healing: God has healed you and kept you well so He can heal others through you! He needs you well so He can flow through you into other peoples' lives because He loves them as much as He loves you! He died for **all** men, not just for you. As you reach out and touch others and help them physically, and meet their needs, and give what God has given you, you will let the Holy Spirit flow through you to others to heal them, to deliver them, and to set them free from every bondage that Satan has had them bound in. *In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake He of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified ( John 7:37-39).* If you stop letting God's power flow through you, it will eventually quit flowing, period.... and you know what that means - if it's not flowing, it's not even flowing to you! *Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils; **freely ye have received, freely give** (Matthew 10:8).*

*And **these signs shall follow** them that **believe**; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover (Mark 16:17, 18).* God's Word says that if you are a believer of God, then you shall be casting out demons, speaking in tongues, and healing the sick by laying hands on them. You are supposed to be **doing** something - **working** for God and letting Him work through you! If you notice, in the midst of your work for God, which is casting demons out and healing the sick, you're supposed to be **in prayer - speaking in tongues**, which is the key! *He that speaketh in an unknown tongue **edifieth himself**; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church (1 Corinthians 14:4).* *But ye, beloved, **building up yourselves** on your most holy faith, **praying in the Holy Ghost** (Jude 1:20).* God's Word says that speaking in tongues builds you up and edifies you. The more you pray in tongues the more clearly your **spiritual** vision will be. You will have **God's** eyesight!

***I am the true vine**, and my Father is the husbandman. Every branch in Me that beareth not **fruit** He taketh away; and every branch that beareth fruit, He purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. Now ye are clean through the Word which I have spoken unto you. **Abide in Me**, and I in you. As the **branch cannot bear fruit of itself**, except it **abide in the vine**; no more can ye, except ye abide in Me. **I am the vine, ye are the branches**; He that **abideth** in Me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth **much fruit**: for without Me ye can do **nothing**. If a man **abide not***

*in Me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is **withered**; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. **If ye abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.** Herein is my Father glorified, that ye **bear much fruit**; so shall ye be My disciples (John 15:1-8).*

In order to **abide** in Jesus, you have to spend **time** with Him in His Word and in prayer. If you look up the word "**abide**" in this verse, it is the Greek word meno. It means to **stay** (in a given place, state, relation or **expectancy**) continue, dwell, endure, be present, remain, stand, tarry. If you want to be immovable and stay in faith, always believing God and His Word to be true over every situation that comes up and expecting it to come to pass, then you have to **abide in Jesus**. You have to **know** Him on an intimate level - you can't just know **about** Him. You have to **know the Word of God** and have it in you so you can believe in Him and know that when you tell an evil spirit to leave a person, it will go. You have to have God's Word on healing so that when you lay hands on someone and command healing that you know they are healed because 1 Peter 2:24 says so, and the healer is in you!

You have to **know** what the Word of God says in order to know what it is that you are supposed to be doing - so you can **obey God**. *But be **doers** of the Word, and **not hearers only**, deceiving your own selves. For if any be a hearer of the Word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: for he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and **continueth** therein, he **being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work**, this man **shall be blessed in his deed** (James 1:22-25).*

*The **fruit** of the righteous is a **tree of life**; and **he that winneth souls is wise** (Proverbs 11:30). A person who wins souls is wise - they have **God's wisdom**. If you aren't winning souls you aren't as smart as you think you are. You don't have **God's wisdom**! *And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned (Mark 16:15, 16). But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; that **if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation** (Romans 10:8-10).* You are saved to save. You are healed to heal. You are prospered to prosper. You are blessed to bless! Begin to abide in Jesus and be a blessing because you have the "blesser" inside of you! **See God's vision** for you, your family, your church, your city, and your nation, and start **acting** on that vision - God's waiting on **you**! Have a*

prosperous, blessed, joyful, peaceful, meaningful and victorious year filled with faith and Love! You have a bright future in God's eyesight!
